



Mishon is an adventure app and its aim is to encourage people to get outdoors and to complete challenges. You can do this on your own, as a family or a Guiding Unit. It's available free anywhere in the world!



- Download the app from the Google Playstore (for android phones) or from the App Store (for iPhones).
- Log in with your email address and set up a profile for you and/or your Unit. See advice for Parents and Leaders when setting up profiles with children on www.themishon.com
- Use the search function at the top to find Irish Girl Guides and follow them. If you check out IGG's other followers you will find lots of members to follow and we can support, like and encourage one another. You can add IGG to your username so other members will know you are in Irish Girl Guides.
- If you are setting up a Unit profile, you can limit who sees the posts by having only your girls in the Unit and they can share with you and the rest of your Unit any photos or videos of programme items they are working on, or activities they complete.
- To ensure your adventures count towards IGG's 363,104km Mishon Moon, you must put #MishonMoon #GirlGuidesWalktotheMoon on your post and it must say the distance covered.
- By interacting with others, verifying their posts, commenting, liking, etc., you will earn points and earn virtual badges. These are visible in your backpack under your Settings.
- You can also do fun challenges like Take a Duck Selfie, Hula Hoops, Hopscotch or a Daily Crate Challenge.

Security Guidelines

When setting up a profile for anyone under 18, keep in mind the following:

- Use an email address the family have access to.
- Choose a profile picture that does not identify too many details e.g. school uniform.
- Choose your privacy settings as private or public.

If private, no user can see your posts or feed, except the friends that you follow. If set to public, anyone can see your posts.

Under 14s: Need parental permission to download the app and should use it in the private setting.

- Only follow people that they know.
- Don't post live videos/photos.
- Choose a general location e.g. nearest town.

14-18 year olds: Can use the app on public or private settings depending on parents' permission.

- Only follow people or interact with people they know.

Mishon work in the education field and have a zero tolerance on bullying. They have created a fun friendly space for everyone to interact and support each other online. Report any inappropriate comments and these will be removed by Mishon. Tap the three buttons on top right of a post to report it. Only people who follow each other can send private direct messages (DM).
