As a charity seeking donations from the public Irish Girl Guides CLG is committed to complying with the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public* (2017) and has formally discussed and adopted the Statement.

Irish Girl Guides confirms its commitment to the principles set out in the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public (2017)*

- by a statement to that effect in its annual report.
- has a Donor Charter which is consistent with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public (2017)
- regularly monitors compliance with the *guidelines* and compliance reports are received by the Board (Executive Committee).
- Irish Girl Guides has appointed the Finance & Audit Committee to be responsible for compliance with the *guidelines*.

Irish Girl Guides provides honest, open and transparent disclosure when fundraising from the public. IGG ensures that fundraisers are provided with information and training on the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public* and its implementation.

Irish Girl Guides has a feedback and complaints procedure Feedback is recorded for review by relevant staff including the CEO and the Board (Executive Committee). Feedback is responded to promptly and appropriately.

Irish Girl Guides prepares financial reports consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 which include a statement concerning the extent to which control of the organisation is independent of its funding sources.

Irish Girl Guides ensures that all donations are tracked and recorded and complies with data protection requirements.

Irish Girl Guides is accessible to the public through a number of readily available contact options.
